# Bertie Bee

DIFFICULTY



UK TERMS



Just look at how cute Bertie is!!!  
 Super easy to make and you could  
 add a cute little keyring too!



## MATERIALS

### YARN

Yarn - Any DK weight yarn 70g  
 Yellow 30g  
 White 20g  
 Black 20g

### HOOK

4mm

### OTHER ITEMS

Yarn needle  
 Scissors  
 2 x 9mm safety eyes  
 Fibre Fill  
 Keyring (optional)

### STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

#### UK Terms

MR - Magic Ring  
 CH - Chain  
 DC - Double Crochet  
 SS - Slip Stitch  
 HTR - Half Treble Crochet  
 TR - Treble Crochet  
 INC - 2 stitches in the same stitch  
 STS - Number of stitches at the  
 end of the round  
 DC2TOG - Decrease Stitch

### NOTES

- The pattern is worked in the round. Anything in ( ) work as many times as stated.
- The wings are working up one side of the chain and then down the other side.
- Optional keyring can be added when complete.

# PATTERN

## Antenna x 2

In **Black** ch5

**Round 1:** In the 2nd chain from the hook 4ss [4 sts]

Break yarn and leave a little tail for sewing onto the bee.

## Bee

In **Yellow** start with a MR

**Round 1:** 6dc into the ring, pull tight [6 sts]

**Round 2:** (1dc inc) x6 [12 sts]

**Round 3:** (1dc, 1dc inc) x6 [18 sts]

**Round 4:** 1dc, 1dc inc, (2dc, 1dc inc) x5, 1dc [24 sts]

**Round 5:** (3dc, 1dc inc) x6 [30 sts]

**Rounds 6-8:** 30dc [30 sts]

Now it's a good idea to place the eyes, antennas and embroider the mouth. I placed my eyes between rounds 3 & 4 and 6 stitches apart. Then I added my antennas between rounds 6 & 7 with 5 stitches apart. I finished the face off by sewing a cute smile just in the centre under the eyes using the Black.

Change to **Black**

**Rounds 9-10:** 30dc round [30 sts]

Change to **Yellow**

**Rounds 11-12:** 30dc round [30 sts]

Change to **Black**

**Rounds 13-14:** 30dc round [30 sts]

Change to **Yellow**

**Rounds 15-16:** 30dc round [30 sts]

Change to **Black**

**Round 17:** 30dc round [30 sts]





### Continued.....

**Round 18:** (3dc, dc2tog) x6 [24 sts]

Change to **Yellow**

**Round 19:** 24dc round [24 sts]

**Round 20:** (2dc, 1dc inc) x6 [18 sts]

Start stuffing the bee firmly.

**Round 21:** (1dc, dc2tog) x6 [12 sts]

**Round 22:** (dc2tog) x6 [6 sts]

Break yarn and close opening sew any loose ends in.



### Wings x2

In **White** ch7 start in the 2nd chain from the hook

**Round 1:** 2ss, 1dc, 1htr, 1tr, 7tr (in last ch and now working back along the ch), 1tr, 1htr, 1dc, 2ss [17 sts]

Break yarn and leave a long tail to sew wings onto the bee.

### Assembly

Sew the wings onto the top of the bee between rounds 11 & 12 (the wings should sit in the central to the eyes).

All finished!!
