UK TERMS

How lovely is this!  
 I have designed this lovely scrap,  
 stripey project bag with added  
 bobbles for texture! I used the lovely  
 Emu yarns cotton DK that I had left  
 over!



## MATERIALS

### YARN

Any scrap Cotton DK - 600g  
 I used Emu Cotton DK -  
 Yarn A - 50g Blossom (006)  
 Yarn B - 50g White (001)  
 Yarn C - 50g Bluebell (011)  
 Yarn D - 50g Sand (009)  
 Yarn E - 50g Postbox (005)  
 Yarn F - 50g Ocean (004)  
 Yarn G - 50g Pistachio (010)  
 Yarn H - 50g Cream (002)  
 Yarn I - 50g Grapefruit (007)  
 Yarn J - 50g Frost (003)  
 Yarn K - 50g Candy (012)  
 Yarn L - 50g Sailor (008)

### HOOK

4mm

### STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

#### UK Terms

Ch - Chain  
 Sl St - Slip Stitch  
 Mr - Magic Ring  
 St(s) - Stitch(es)  
 Dc - Double Crochet  
 Inc - Increase

#### OTHER ITEMS

Yarn needle  
 Scissors

#### FINISHED SIZE

Basket - Approximately 23cm x 28cm

#### GAUGE

22sts x 26 rows = 10cm x 10cm

### NOTES OR SPECIAL STITCHES

- The pattern is worked in the round.
- Change colour every round.
- Chain 1 at the beginning of the round, does not count as a stitch.

#### Special Stitch

**Bobble Stitch (Bo)** - Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, (2 loops on your hook), \*yarn over, insert hook into same stitch, pull through, yarn over, pull through 2; repeat from \* until you have 6 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through all 6 loops on your hook

## PATTERN

**To Start – In Yarn A start with a MR.**

**Round 1:** 6dc into the ring, pull tight [6 sts]

**Round 2:** Yarn B, (dc inc) x 6 [12 sts]

**Round 3:** Yarn C, (1dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [18 sts]

**Round 4:** Yarn D, (2dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [24 sts]

**Round 5:** Yarn E, (3dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [30 sts]

**Round 6:** Yarn F, (4dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [36 sts]

**Round 7:** Yarn G, (5dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [42 sts]

**Round 8:** Yarn H, (6dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [48 sts]

**Round 9:** Yarn I, (7dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [54 sts]

**Round 10:** Yarn J, (8dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [60 sts]

**Round 11:** Yarn K, (9dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [66 sts]

**Round 12:** Yarn L, (10dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [72 sts]

**Round 13:** Yarn A, (11dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [78 sts]

**Round 14:** Yarn B, (12dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [84 sts]

**Round 15:** Yarn C, (13dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [90 sts]

**Round 16:** Yarn D, (14dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [96 sts]

**Round 17:** Yarn E, (15dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [102 sts]

**Round 18:** Yarn F, (16dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [108 sts]

**Round 19:** Yarn G, (17dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [114 sts]

**Round 26:** Yarn B, (24dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [156 sts]

**Round 27:** Yarn C, (25dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [162 sts]

**Round 28:** Yarn D, (26dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [168 sts]

**Round 29:** Yarn E, (27dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [174 sts]

**Round 30:** Yarn F, (28dc, 1dc inc) x 6 [180 sts]

**Round 31:** Yarn G, 180dc [180 sts]

**Round 81:** Yarn I, 35dc, 20dc into each ch, 70dc, 20dc into each ch, 35dc [180 sts]  
**Round 82:** Yarn J, 180dc [180 sts]  
**Round 83:** Yarn K, 180dc [180 sts]  
**Round 84:** Yarn L, 180dc [180 sts]

Weave in all ends.
