



CROCHET PATTERN

Cosy Amanda Cowl

DIFFICULTY



UK TERMS



A beautiful, quick and easy cowl! And it's also perfect for beginners too!



MATERIALS

YARN

Yarn – Any Aran weight yarn will be fine in 2 different colours.
I used the below shades of Deramores Studio Aran Yarn
50g Watermelon
50g Emerald

HOOK

6.5mm

FINISHED SIZE

Size - approximately 34cm x 15cm

STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

UK Terms

CH - Chain

DC – Double Crochet

TR- Treble Crochet

STS – Number of stitches at the end of the round

OTHER ITEMS

Yarn needle

Scissors

NOTES

- Ch1 at the beginning of each round DOES NOT count as a stitch.
- Pattern is worked in the round.
- Be careful not to twist you chain when you join it.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Cluster V-Stitch - *yarn over, insert the hook in indicated st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull back through 2 loops on the hook, yarn over, insert the hook in same st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull back through 2 loops on the hook, yarn over, pull back through 3 loops on the hook* Ch 1, insert the hook into the same stitch and repeat from * to *.



PATTERN

To Start – 6.5mm hook, in Emerald chain 81 join with a ss to the first chain to form a ring, be careful not to twist your chain as you will be working into the chain stitches.

Round 1

Into the chain stitches dc in each stitch around, ss to first dc [81 sts]

Round 2

Ch1, 1dc in each stitch, ss to first dc [81 sts]

Round 3 Join Watermelon

Ch1, *cluster v-stitch, skip 2 stitches** repeat from * to ** to the end, ss to the top of the first cluster [81 sts, 27 clusters]

Round 4 Join Emerald

Ch1, cluster v-stitch in the middle of each V-stitch from previous round to the end, ss to the top of the first cluster [81 sts, 27 clusters]

Round 5 Join Watermelon

Repeat round 4.

Round 6 Join Emerald

Repeat round 4.

Round 7 Join Watermelon

Repeat round 4.

Round 8 Join Emerald

Repeat round 4.

Round 9 Join Watermelon

Repeat round 4.

Rounds 10 – 11 Join Emerald

Repeat round 2.

To Finish - Break yarn, sew all ends in.
