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## Teeny-Weeny Whale

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## What You'll Need

3mm Crochet Hook

Scrap yarn no bigger than DK (unless you change hook accordingly) in Any main colour of your choice, White and Black

Scissors

Stuffing

Tapestry/Wool Needle

## Abbreviations

MR – Magic Ring

CH – Chain

SS – Slip Stitch

SC – Single Crochet

PICOT – Picot (See special stitches below)

INC – 2 stitches in the same stitch

STS – Number of stitches at the end of the round

BLO – Back Loop Only

SC2TOG – Decrease Stitch

## Pattern

Pattern written in US Terms

### **Notes:**

The whale is worked in the round.

Anything in ( ) work as many times as stated.

Special Stitch **PICOT** - Chain 3, ss into 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from the hook.

Round 7 will work the whale's tail and fins. The tail part will be worked all into 1 stitch.

Round 8 will be the first white round for the bottom of the whale and is worked in the Back Loop Only, you also need to miss the back of the tail and fins.

## Whale

In **Your Main Colour Choice** start with a MR

**Round 1:** 6sc into the ring, pull tight [6 sts]

**Round 2:** (sc inc) x 6 [12 sts]

**Round 3:** (1sc, 1sc inc) x 6 [18 sts]

**Round 4 – 6:** 18sc round [18 sts]

**Round 7:** SEE NOTES - 1sc, \*ch5, 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from the hook, 3dc, ss\*\* repeat from \* to \*\* one more time to finish the tail, 5sc, Picot, ss into last sc just made, 7sc, Picot, ss into last sc just made, 5sc [18 sts] **See below.**



Change to **White**

**Round 8:** SEE NOTES - BLO (1sc, sc2tog) x 6 [12 sts] **see below.**



Here you need to embroider your eyes. I did mine just in front of each fin in a 'V' shape, **see pics below.** Also stuff your whale here.



**Round 9:** (sc2tog) x 6 [6 sts]

Break yarn and close opening sew any loose ends in.



Ta da!!!!!! You have made a teeny-weeny whale!!!!
