## Fluffy Marshmallow Blanket

## What You'll Need

8mm Crochet Hook

Scissors

Tapestry/Wool Needle

Cot Bed Size – 7 x balls of Baby Soft Aldi Yarn

Single Bed Size – 10 x balls of Baby Soft Aldi Yarn

## Abbreviations

CH - Chain

SS – Slip Stitch

SC – Single Crochet

ST – Stitch

## Notes

Patterns written in US Terms

Each colour block uses 1x ball of wool

Each colour block contains 15 rows apart from the first and last blocks

Ch1 at the beginning of each row DOES NOT count as a stitch

Turn at the end of each row

## Pattern for Cot Bed Size Blanket

Size - approximately 32"x 44" inches

Take your first colour

Chain 91

**Row 1:** sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, sc across, turn [90 sts]

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (sc, skip 1st, ch1, sc in next) – repeat to the end, *the last stitch should be a sc*, turn [90 sts]

**Rows 3 – 14:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 15 – 29:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 30 – 44:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 45 – 59:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 60 – 74:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 75 – 89:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 90 – 102:** Repeat Row 2

**Row 103:** Ch1, sc across [90 sts]

**To finish:** sew ends in.

## Pattern for Cot Bed Size Blanket

Size - approximately 40"x 60" inches

Take your first colour

Chain 115

**Row 1:** sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, sc across, turn [114 sts]

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (sc, skip 1st, ch1, sc in next) – repeat to the end, *the last stitch should be a sc*, turn [114 sts]

**Rows 3 – 12:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 13 – 25:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 26 – 38:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 39 – 51:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 52 – 64:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 65 – 77:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 78 – 90:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 91 – 103:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 104 – 116:** Repeat Row 2

Change to next colour

**Rows 117 – 127:** Repeat Row 2

**Row 128:** Ch1, sc across [114 sts]



**To finish:** sew ends in.
