# Nest of Chunky Baskets

DIFFICULTY



UK TERMS



A beautiful nest of spike stitch baskets! Each one fits perfectly into the other made using chunky yarn so they work up quickly too! Also perfect for beginners too!



#### FINISHED SIZES

Small basket - Approximately 18cm x 10cm.

Medium basket - Approximately 20cm x 13cm.

Large basket - Approximately 23cm x 15cm.

## MATERIALS

#### YARN

Yarn - Any Chunky weight yarn  
I used approx. 500g of Deramores  
Chunky:

- Yarn A - 100g Teal
- Yarn B - 100g White
- Yarn C - 100g Pink
- Yarn D - 200g Grey

#### HOOK

8mm

#### GAUGE

16 sts x 10 rows = 10cm x 10cm

#### OTHER ITEMS

Yarn needle  
Scissors

#### STITCH ABBREVIATIONS

##### UK Terms

Ch - Chain

MR - Magic Ring

SS - Slip Stitch

St/s - Stitch/es

DC - Double Crochet

BLO - Back Loop Only

FLO - Front Loop Only

[...] - Repeat the sequence between the square brackets by the number indicated.

(.. sts) - The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the number of stitches after working the row.

#### NOTES

Baskets are made in the round.

#### SPECIAL STITCHES

Dc Spike Stitch – Insert Hook 2 rows below, pull yarn through up to the height of the current row, yarn over, pull yarn through the 2 loops on the hook.



## PATTERN

### Small Basket

Using **Yarn A** start with a MR.

**Round 1:** 6 dc. pull ring tight (6 sts)

**Round 2:** [2 dc in next st] six times. (12 sts)

**Round 3:** [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (18 sts)

**Round 4:** [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (24 sts)

**Round 5:** [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (30 sts)

**Round 6:** [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (36 sts)

**Round 7:** [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (42 sts)

**Round 8:** [6 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (48 sts)

**Round 9:** [7 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (54 sts)

**Round 10:** [8 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (60 sts)

**Round 11:** BLO, 60 dc around (60 sts)

**Rounds 12-14:** 60 dc around (60 sts)

Change to **Yarn B**

**Round 15:** [1 dc, 1 dc spike] thirty times. (60 sts)

**Rounds 16-17:** 60 dc around (60 sts)

**Note:** Round 18 is where we create the handles.

**Round 18:** 15 dc, 10 ch, miss 8 sts, 22 dc, 10 ch, miss 8 sts, 7 dc. (60 sts)

**Round 19:** 15 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 22 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 7 dc. (60 sts)

**Round 20:** FLO, ss in each stitch around. (60 sts)

Cut the yarn and sew the ends in.

## Medium Basket

Using **Yarn C** start with a MR.

**Round 1:** 6 dc, pull ring tight (6 sts)

**Round 2:** [2 dc in next st] six times. (12 sts)

**Round 3:** [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (18 sts)

**Round 4:** [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (24 sts)

**Round 5:** [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (30 sts)

**Round 6:** [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (36 sts)

**Round 7:** [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (42 sts)

**Round 8:** [6 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (48 sts)

**Round 9:** [7 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (54 sts)

**Round 10:** [8 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (60 sts)

**Round 11:** [9 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (66 sts)

**Round 12:** [10 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (72 sts)

**Round 13:** BLO, 72 dc around (72 sts)

**Rounds 14-17:** 72 dc around (72 sts)

Change to **Yarn B**.

**Round 18:** [1 dc, 1 dc spike] thirty-six times. (72 sts)

**Rounds 19-21:** 72 dc around (72 sts)

**Note:** Round 22 is where we create the handles.

**Round 22:** 21 dc, 10 ch, miss 8, 28 dc, 10 ch, miss 8, 7 dc. (72 sts)

**Round 23:** 21 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 28 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 7 dc. (72 sts)

**Round 24:** FLO, ss in each stitch around. (72 sts)

Cut the yarn and sew the ends in.

## Large Basket

Using **Yarn D** start with a MR.

**Round 1:** 6 dc. pull ring tight (6 sts)

**Round 2:** [2 dc in next st] six times. (12 sts)

**Round 3:** [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (18 sts)

**Round 4:** [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (24 sts)

**Round 5:** [3 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (30 sts)

**Round 6:** [4 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (36 sts)

**Round 7:** [5 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (42 sts)

**Round 8:** [6 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (48 sts)

**Round 9:** [7 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (54 sts)

**Round 10:** [8 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (60 sts)

**Round 11:** [9 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (66 sts)

**Round 12:** [10 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (72 sts)

**Round 13:** [11 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (78 sts)

**Round 14:** [12 dc, 2 dc in next st] six times. (84 sts)

**Round 15:** BLO, 84 dc around (84 sts)

**Rounds 16-20:** 84 dc around (84 sts)



Change to **Yarn B**.

**Round 21:** [1 dc, 1 dc spike] forty-two times. (84 sts)

**Rounds 22-25:** 84 dc around (84 sts)

**Note:** Round 26 is where we create the handles.

**Round 26:** 27 dc, 10 ch, miss 8, 34 dc, 10 ch, miss 8, 7 dc. (84 sts)

**Round 27:** 27 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 34 dc, 8 dc around the 10 ch, 7 dc. (84 sts)

**Round 28:** FLO, ss in each stitch around. (84 sts)

Cut the yarn and sew the ends in.
