What You'll Need

2.50mm Crochet Hook

Scrap yarn no bigger than DK (unless you change hook accordingly)

I used Yarn and Colours Mini range

1 x Mini button

Scissors

Tapestry/Wool Needle

Abbreviations

MC – Magic Circle

SS – Slip Stitch

SC – Single Crochet

CH- Chain

Sc2tog – Single Crochet 2 Together

Pattern

Pattern written in US Terms

Note: Main part of the pattern works in the round no need to join unless advised.

Base

Start with a MC and work 6 sc into the ring, pull tight and join with a ss to first sc.

Round 1: 2 sc in each stitch around (12sts).

Round 2 – 6: sc in each stitch around working in a spiral

Flap

Round 7: Turn, ch1, sc in next 6 sts (6)

Round 8: Turn, ch1, sc2tog, sc in next 2, sc2tog

Round 9: Turn, Ch1, sc2tog x2

Button Hole

Round 10: Turn, ch4, ss into last stitch on the row.

Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.

Add your button and your mini pouch is now done 😊
